

The Dixon Family Scholarship

1. Scholarships must be submitted by the specified due date to be determined each year.
2. Refer to the criteria below for eligibility requirements.
3. Type or print legibly. You may also download a copy of the application online at hallstromhomeschool.org
4. The award recipient will be determined by a Scholarship Committee and announced during the Hallstrom Homeschool Workshops graduation ceremony.

Purpose:

To provide a \$1,000 scholarship to a deserving graduating Hallstrom senior with plans to attend a 2-year or 4-year accredited college or university to pursue a career serving the Lord in faith-based or secular work.

Criteria:

1. Applicant must be a Hallstrom Homeschool Workshops graduating senior, who completed at least one academic class at Hallstrom during his or her senior year.
2. Applicant must have been homeschooled for many years.
3. Applicant must have excelled to his or her best academically.
4. Applicant must have exhibited positive social interaction, developed trustworthy friendships, and reached out to others in need in the community during their high school career.
5. Applicant must possess a deep faith and saving knowledge of the Lord Jesus Christ, walking with Him daily and desiring to grow ever closer to Him.
6. Applicant must plan to pursue higher education to serve the Lord in either secular or faith-based work.

Application Process:

Applicant must submit the following items:

1. Completed application form (if hand-written, please print legibly)
2. A transcript with a cumulative grade point average
3. Completion of an essay
4. Submit all aforementioned paperwork to the designated location.

Payment of Award:

The scholarship award will be paid directly to the college of your choice after proper documentation (proof of registration and tuition bill) has been provided to Hallstrom Home School Workshops. If documentation to claim payment is not submitted within 1 year of the date of award, the recipient will forfeit the scholarship.
